## Relevant Project Work

### Project 1: Completed in December 2019

- Topic:** The subject was called Personal Finance and the project was about analysing a client's financial position to render a Statement of Advice for them in the future.
- Findings:** The results were for the client to re-manage his finances to be beneficial for himself and also his family.
- Learned Competencies:** This project engrained the framework of a teamwork mindset. Each member had a specialty and all of us worked at our best to maximize our result.

### Project 2: Completed in August 2020

- Topic:** The subject was *Financial Markets and Institutions* and the project question was "is Bitcoin a viable hedge against the market?". It was a group of four during the time of COVID-19.
- Findings:** We analyzed the use of Gold as a hedge as a level of comparison through the rough market period surrounding COVID-19. We found that Bitcoin was more negatively correlated to the market than gold which came as a surprise to the group. As Bitcoin is a new currency it is difficult to say whether it is a viable hedge as it has not been tested.
- Learned Competencies:** I learnt how to use comparability with the help of Bloomberg terminals to produce results. Also, I learnt how the use of teamwork can help produce quality results even if the situation isn't ideal.
